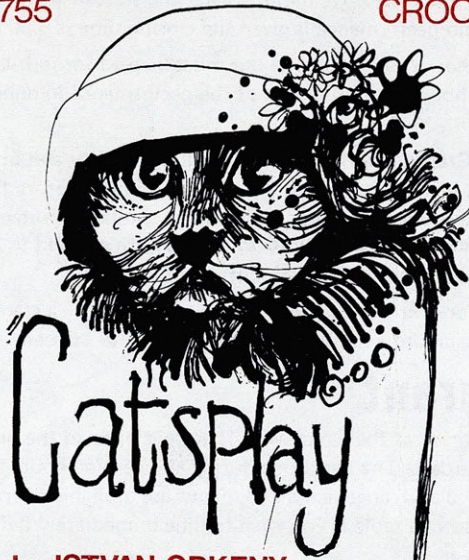

Booking facilities

The Box Office opens daily at 10.00 a.m. (except on Sundays, Good Friday and Christmas Day) and closes five minutes after the start of the evening performance. On evenings when no performance is given the closing time is 6.00 p.m.

Seats may be reserved by telephone but must be paid for in full within 3 normal working days or half an hour before the start of the performance in question, whichever is the sooner.

Friends of the Greenwich Theatre have booking priority and in their case telephone reservations are held for one week or until ten minutes before the start of the performance, whichever is the sooner. (Friends may enjoy a similar advantage at many West End theatres through the Theatre Arts Society to which they are entitled to Affiliate Membership at a reduced subscription. Ask at the Box Office for details).

Postal applications for tickets should be accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope; cheques and postal orders should be made payable to "Greenwich Theatre Ltd."

Restaurant

Barnards Restaurant at the Greenwich Theatre is open to the public for lunch and dinner Monday – Saturday. The bars open during all licensing hours to the public and theatre-goers alike. Special arrangements and menus are available for party bookings. It is always advisable to reserve a table if you wish to dine immediately before or after a show.

Seat prices & party discounts

Seat Prices are £1.20, 88p, 66p including V.A.T.

A Party Discount of 10% for organised party bookings of 12 or more is offered on all seat prices at all performances with the exception of Previews, Saturday Evenings and certain other performances of Christmas productions.

Transport subsidies

Coach Parties may qualify for the G.L.A.A. transport subsidy which cover 50% of the cost of coach hire. Full details are available on request from Administration.

O.A.P & student concessions

Subject to the availability of seats, senior citizens may purchase seats at half price for Monday evening and Saturday early performances. Bona fide full time students have a concession of 10% for the same performances.

Even greater reductions are available at Saturday early performances for parties of 20 or more senior citizens. Such bookings must be made through the Theatre Sales Representative.

The management reserves the right to extend or withdraw these concessions without notice.
